Pre-School	Russian	Girls: Red Dress with white belt and a red/white hair bow or flower Boys: Black pants with white shirt and red belt.
Level 1 5-8 & 8+	Mexico	colorful skirt, white tank top/ shirt with a hair bow or flower ***no longer than knee length skirts or they will not be able to do the skills required****
Level 1 Advanced	Hawaiian	pink, blue green or yellow tank top/shirt. (Students will be provided with a grass hula skirt.)
Level 2	American Rock n Roll	pink or black skirt ,white shirt and a belt (black belt if skirt is pink, or any color belt if skirt is black) ***no longer than knee length skirts or they will not be able to do the skills required****
Level 2 Advanced	Indian	Black leggings, sparkling t-shirt with sequences and or glitter
Little Advanced	Japanese	Red skirt, White long sleeved shirt and white flower or bow for hair ***no longer than knee length skirts or they will not be able to do the skills required****
XCEL	Ireland	Green dress and black leggings
Hot Shots	Greece	Toga with a leaf head band
